Note:

- Eligibility for the Advanced Mountaineering Courses shall be restricted to candidates who have obtained an “A” Grade in the Basic Mountaineering Course from a recognized Mountaineering Institute. Eligibility for the Advanced Skiing Courses shall be restricted to candidates who have obtained an “A” Grade in both the Basic Skiing Course and the Intermediate Skiing Course from a recognized Mountaineering Institute.**
- Arrival shall be one day prior to the commencement of the course, and departure shall be one day after the completion of the course. The same shall be strictly adhered to by all participants.**

1. TRANSFER OF SEAT:

(a) A seat may be transferred, on request made at least one month prior to the commencement of the course, to the next available batch, subject to the availability of a seat. A transfer fee of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) shall be charged for such transfer. In case a participant seeks transfer of the seat to a course scheduled in the following year, an additional amount equivalent to 10% of the course fee already paid shall be payable, in addition to the transfer fee of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only).

2. **SPECIAL VACANCIES:**

(a) The Institute has the provision to accommodate up to thirty (30) additional participants in each course over and above the approved course strength, subject to availability and as per the course schedule. The fee structure applicable to such additional seats is as follows:

3. **SPECIAL ADVENTURE /SKIING (05/06/07/08/09/10DAYS)**

(a) Special Adventure Courses and Special Skiing Courses can be organized for groups on request, subject to the Institute's existing training commitments. These courses may be conducted at Pahalgam, Sanasar, Bhaderwah, Sonamarg, or Leh. The dates of Skiing Courses are subject to change depending upon weather and snow conditions. The fee structure for these courses is as under:

(b) The above-mentioned fee structure covers food, accommodation, training equipment, and first-aid facilities during the course. No escort shall be permitted with individual trainees. However, escorts may be allowed only in respect of Special Courses conducted for registered schools.

4. **Fee Structure for Foreigners**

(a) **The fee structure for various courses for foreign students is as given below: -**

5. **Deduction of Course fees**

(a) **The following deductions shall be applicable in the event of cancellation of a seat:**

- (I) Cancellation made three (03) months prior to the commencement of the course – 15% of the course fee.
- (II) Cancellation made two (02) months prior to the commencement of the course – 25% of the course fee.
- (III) Cancellation made one (01) month prior to the commencement of the course – 50% of the course fee.

(IV) If cancellation is made less than one (1) month before the commencement of the course, no refund of the course fee will be provided

6. **How to apply**

(a) Candidates seeking admission to any course of the Institute shall apply online through the Institute's website, www.jawaharinstitutepahalgam.com by filling the prescribed Application Form and depositing the requisite course fee online. Offline applications may be entertained only in exceptional circumstances with the approval of the Institute.

(b) The Institute will provide all mountaineering and skiing equipment, as well as specialized clothing required during the course. Participants are, however, required to arrange their personal items independently. A detailed list of the recommended personal clothing and accessories can be accessed at:

Participants are advised to carefully review the list and ensure that all required personal items are brought with them at the time of reporting for the course.

7. **Administrative Details**

The administrative details pertaining to the courses are as follows:

- (I) Adventure sports and outdoor activities inherently involve certain risks of physical injury. Participants are required to understand and acknowledge these risks before enrolling in the course. Participation in all activities is entirely voluntary.
- (II) Students will be relieved from the Institute after breakfast on the last day of the course. To ensure a comfortable return journey, participants are advised to make their travel reservations well in advance.
- (III) The medium of instruction for all training courses shall be Hindi and English.
- (IV) All queries related to courses and administrative matters should be addressed only to the Principal, Medical Officer, or Training Clerk of the Institute.

8. **Insurance Cover for Trainees**

(a) All students undergoing mountaineering, adventure, or skiing courses at Jawahar Institute of Mountaineering & Winter Sports (JIM&WS) are required to obtain valid insurance coverage for the entire duration of the course. Participants must report to the Institute with the relevant insurance documents.

(b) The insurance policy must provide adequate coverage against accidents, death, permanent or temporary disability, loss of limb, and any illness or injury that may occur while participating in training activities conducted by the Institute.

9. **Climatic Conditions**

Pahalgam

- (a) Pahalgam enjoys a cool and pleasant climate during the summer months and experiences severe cold during winter. The most suitable period for adventure activities is from April to October.
- (b) Winters (November to March) are cold and snowbound, with temperatures frequently falling below freezing point. The region receives substantial snowfall, offering spectacular views of snow-covered mountains and landscapes.
- (c) Summers (April to June) are mild and pleasant, with temperatures generally ranging between 11°C and 25°C. Occasional showers may occur during this period. While snowfall is absent in the valley, snow can still be found at higher altitudes.
- (d) The monsoon season (July to September) is generally mild, with relatively low rainfall. However, humidity levels may increase during this period.

Sanasar

- (a) Sanasar experiences a cool and pleasant climate during summer and a very cold climate during winter. The ideal season for adventure activities extends from April to October.
- (b) Winters (October to March) are cold and snowbound, with temperatures often dropping below 0°C. Fresh snowfall is common, creating picturesque snow-covered surroundings.
- (c) Summers (April to June) are pleasant, with temperatures ranging between 15°C and 30°C. Light showers may occur occasionally, while higher reaches may continue to retain snow.
- (d) Monsoons (July to September) are relatively mild, with limited rainfall. Humidity levels may be moderately high during this season.

Bhaderwah

- (a) Bhaderwah enjoys a pleasant climate during summer and experiences severe cold during winter. The best period for adventure activities is from April to October.

- (b) Winters (November to March) are cold and snowbound, with temperatures frequently falling below freezing point. Regular snowfall transforms the region into a scenic winter landscape.
- (c) Summers (April to June) are comfortable and pleasant, with temperatures ranging between 15°C and 30°C. Intermittent rainfall may occur, while snow remains visible on the higher peaks and ridges.

Leh (Ladakh)

- (a) Leh (Ladakh) experiences a dry climate with warm summers and extremely cold winters. The most suitable period for adventure activities is from May to September.
- (b) Winters (October to April) are harsh, with temperatures often falling well below freezing point. Snowfall is common in the surrounding high-altitude regions.
- (c) Summers (May to September) are generally dry and pleasant, with daytime temperatures ranging between 15°C and 30°C. Rainfall is minimal due to the region's cold desert climate. Snow remains visible on the higher mountain peaks throughout much of the year.

Sonamarg

- (a) Sonamarg enjoys a cool and pleasant climate during summer and experiences severe cold during winter. The most suitable period for adventure activities is from June to October.
- (b) Winters (November to March) are cold and snowbound, with temperatures often dropping below freezing point. The region receives substantial snowfall and offers magnificent views of snow-covered mountains and valleys.
- (c) Summers (April to October) are pleasant, with temperatures generally ranging between 11°C and 25°C. Occasional showers may occur during this period. Snow is usually absent in the valley but remains visible at higher elevations.
